RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN (RMP) DOCUMENT REVIEW

CALIFORNIA ACCIDENTAL RELEASE PREVENTION (CalARP) PROGRAM

In accordance with the California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 6.95, Article 2, Section 25535.2 and the California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Division 2, Chapter 4.5, Section 5070.2, notice is hereby given that the Risk Management Plan (RMP), dated April 2024, has been accepted as complete for the following stationary source facilities:

The RMP is a detailed engineering analysis of the potential accident factors present at the facility and the mitigation measures that can be implemented to reduce this accident potential.

The purpose of the RMP is to reduce the risk of an accidental release for the Program Level Two (2), Chlorine covered process from the stationary source facilities.

The RMP is available for public review and comment for forty-five (45) calendar days from the date of this posting. Any interested party may review and comment on these plans at the County of Santa Cruz Environmental Health Division (CSCEHD) office, by appointment only, at the following location:
